In chemistry, a carbene is a molecule containing a neutral carbon atom with a valence of two and two unshared valence electrons. The general formula is $R-(C:)-R'$ or $R=C:$ where the R represent substituents or hydrogen atoms.. The term "carbene" may also refer to the specific compound $H_2C:$, also called methylene, the parent hydride from which all other carbene compounds are formally derived.
