The Heliothinae contains but one species in Europe and so this subfamily does not take many pages, Schoenobiinae are treated in a similar manner to Acentropinae, with a few keys included. The Scopariinae, on account of their greater numbers, occupy about half of the book. The species accounts are concise but appear accurate.
